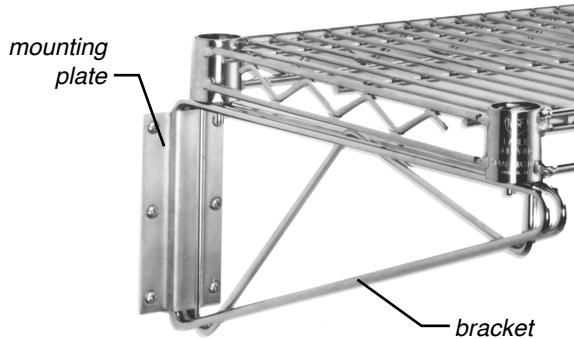


Stationary Wall Brackets

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

CAUTION

Parts List

1	mounting plate
1	bracket

1) Mounting Plate

Place the mounting plate through the vertical section of the wall bracket as shown in the picture.

2) Positioning

Hold the bracket to the wall in the desired mounting location and ensure proper spacing is allowed for the shelf length. Mark the location of the holes in the mounting plate.

Note: Depending on construction of wall, brackets should be attached to studs, in-wall-grounds, or solid part of brick or concrete wall with appropriate fasteners*. Six fasteners* must be used per bracket for proper stability.

Hint: Place the shelf over the bracket before marking the mounting plate locations. This will help with proper location of bracket, and aid in the overall mounting process. Check the shelf with a level, prior to mounting. If the wall is not plumb, spacer washers* should be added.

* Mounting screws and spacers are not included.

3) Secure

Mount brackets securely to the wall. Place shelf over brackets.



WARNING – IMPORTANT NOTES



- Heavier objects should be stored at lower levels.
- Always be sure shelves are properly leveled.
- Do not step, stand, climb, or hang on shelving.
- Do not drop heavy objects onto shelves.
- Never overload shelving.

Failure to follow these guidelines can result in property damage or personal injury.

Note: Wall mounted units must be attached to a properly constructed and sound wall. For walls constructed of wood or steel studs, the mounting points must be directly on the stud or suitable in-wall-grounds of plywood or sheet metal.
